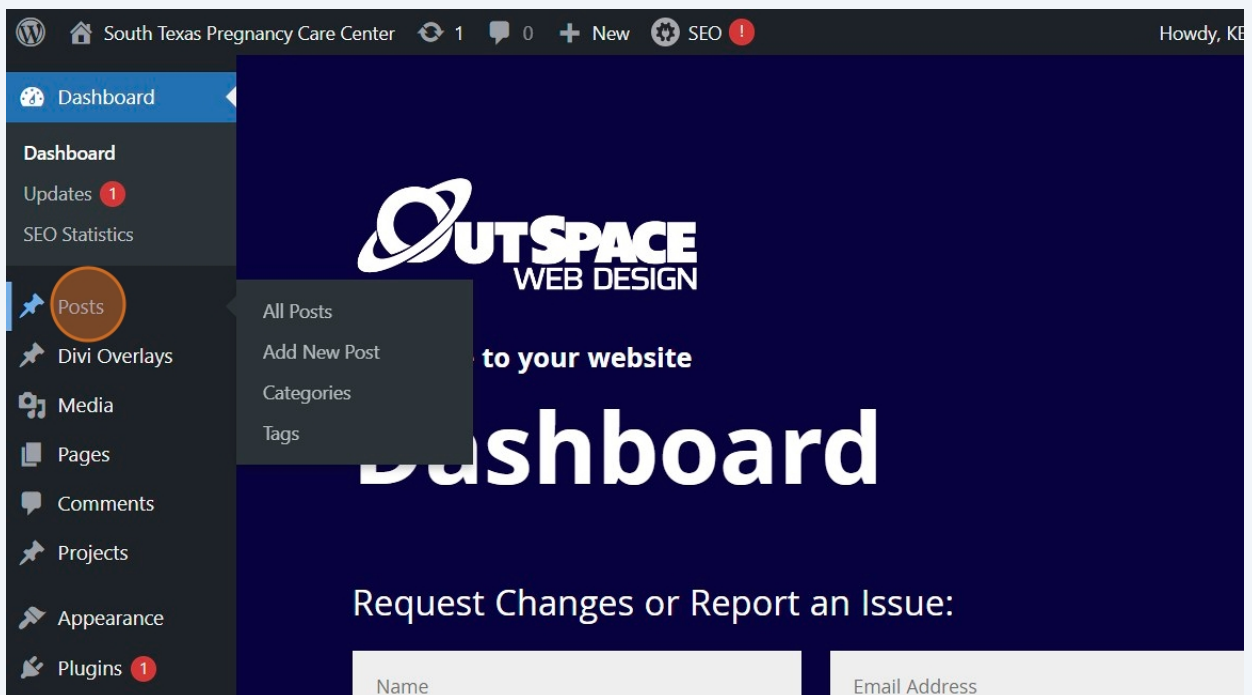


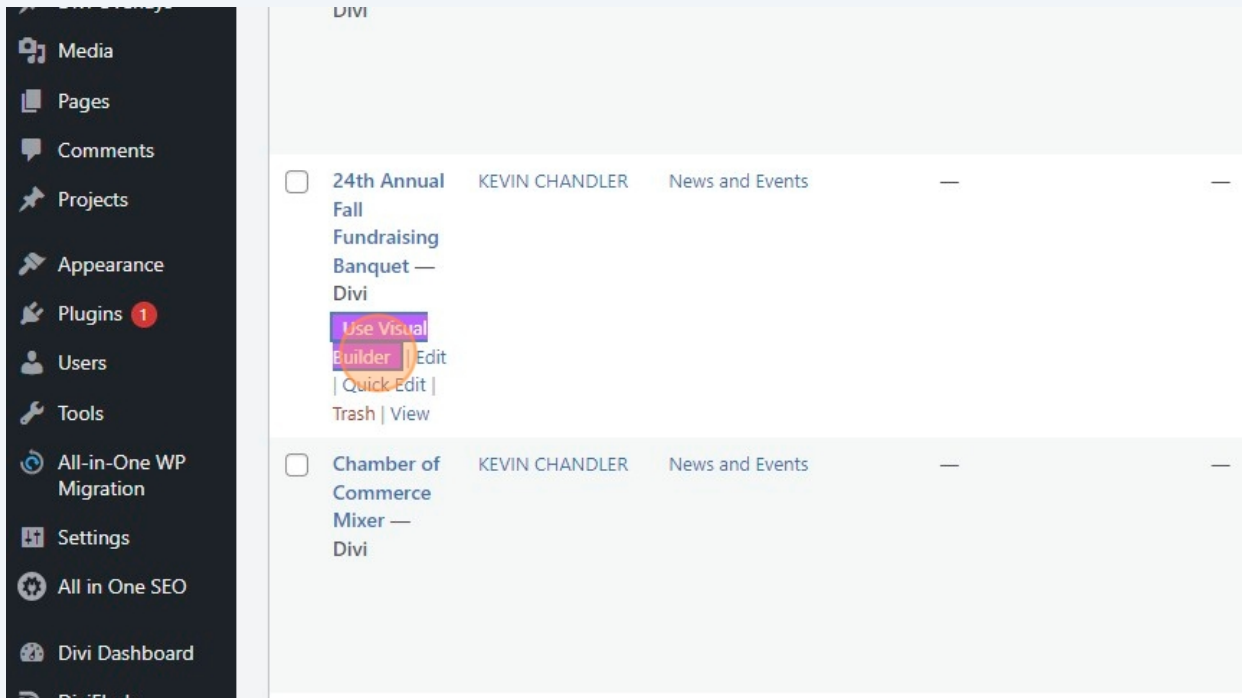
# How To Use The Visual Builder For Posts

1 Navigate to <https://southtexaspregnancycenter.com/login>

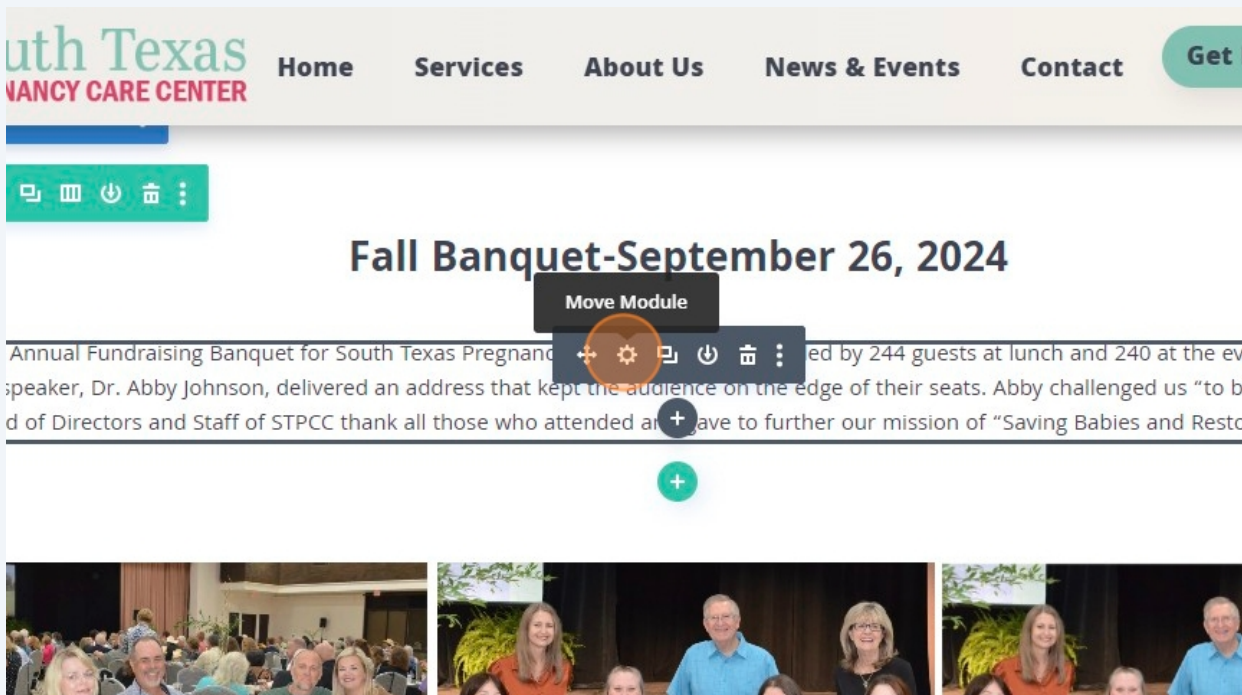
2 Click "Posts"

4 Click this Gear icon for the module you want to edit.



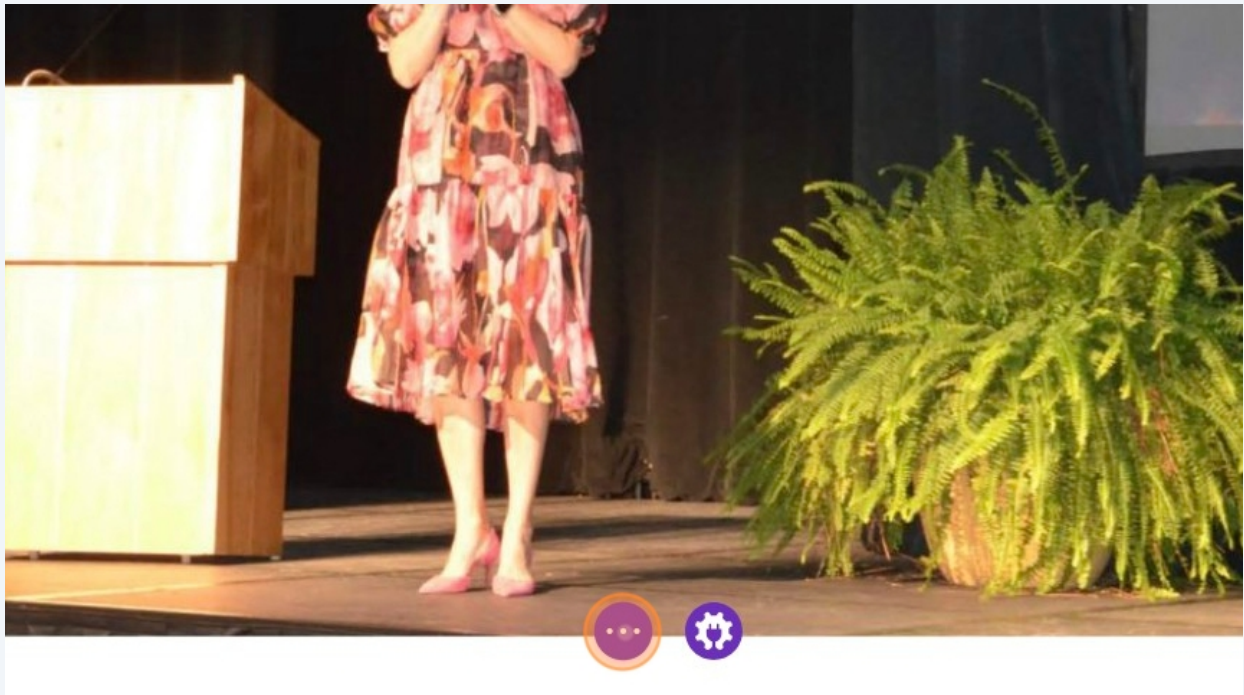
5 Click the "Content" tab.

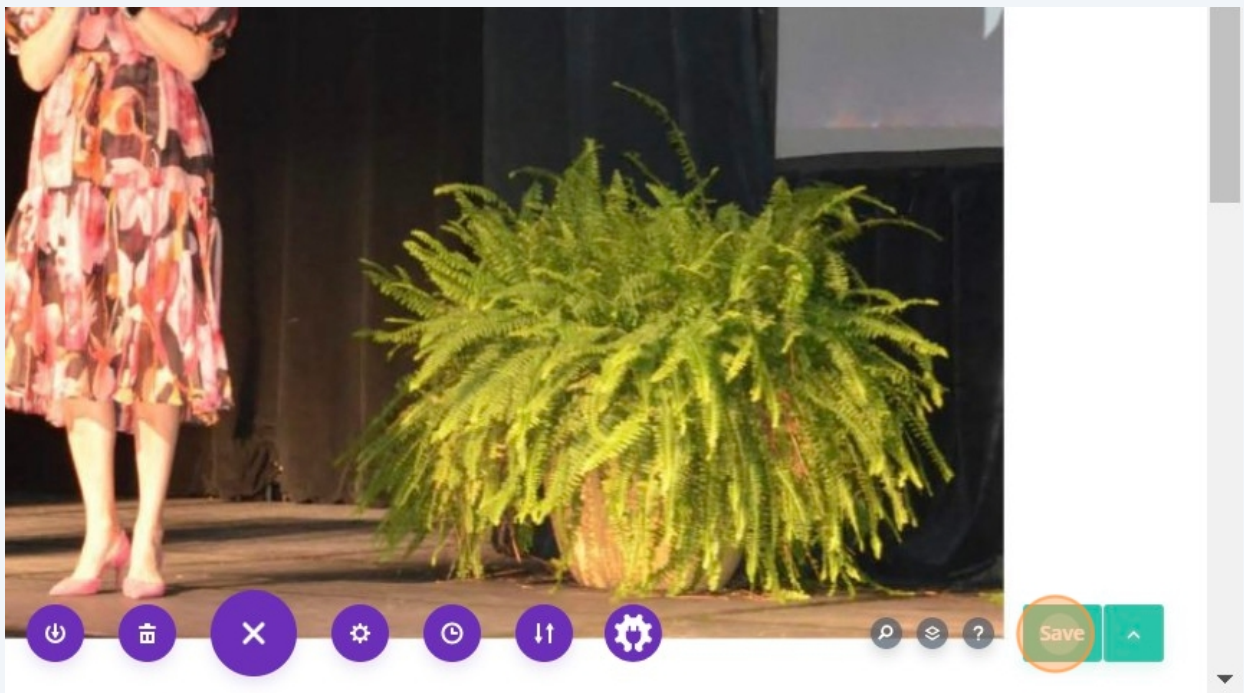
6 Once your edits are complete, Click the green check button to save the module.
